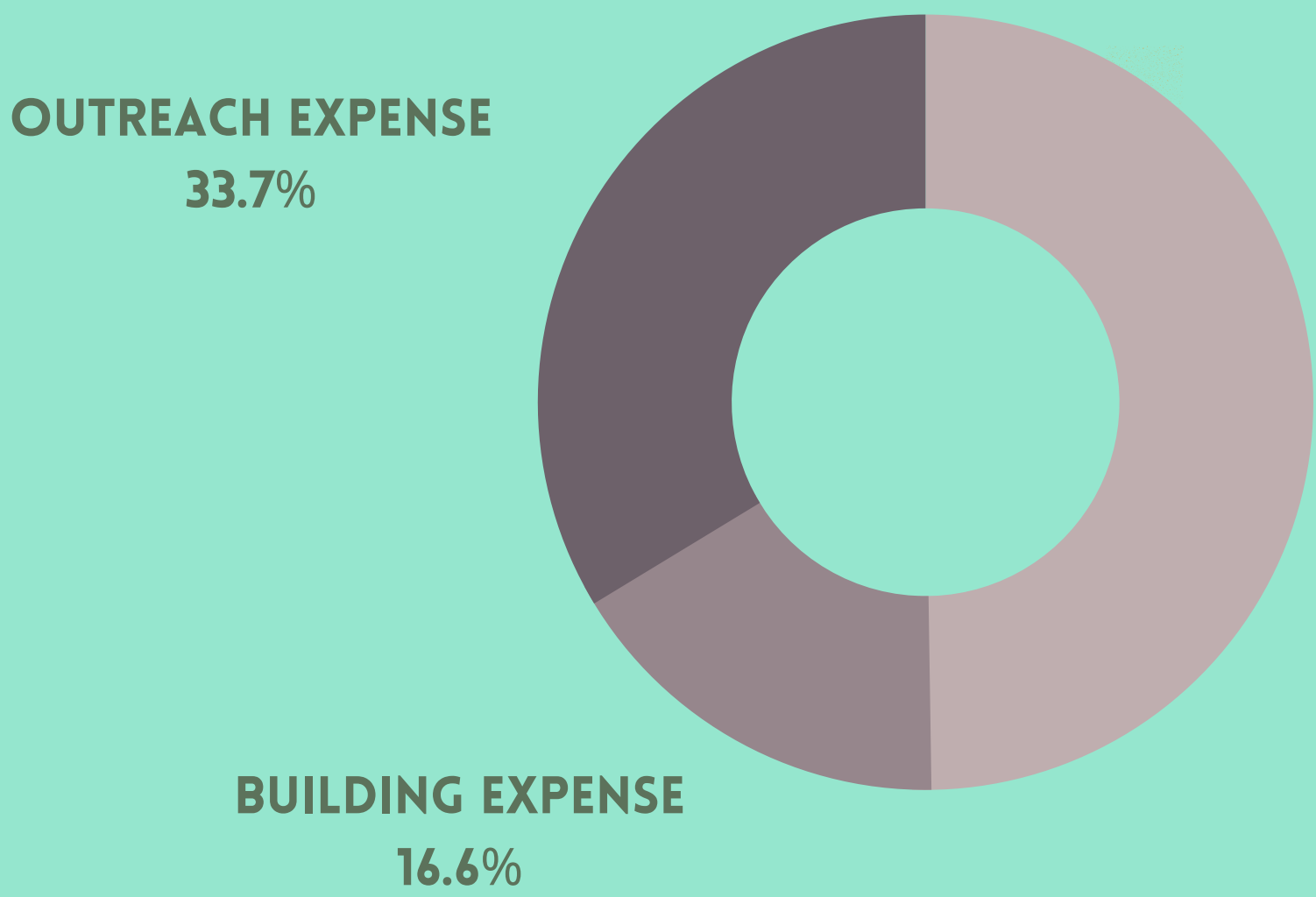
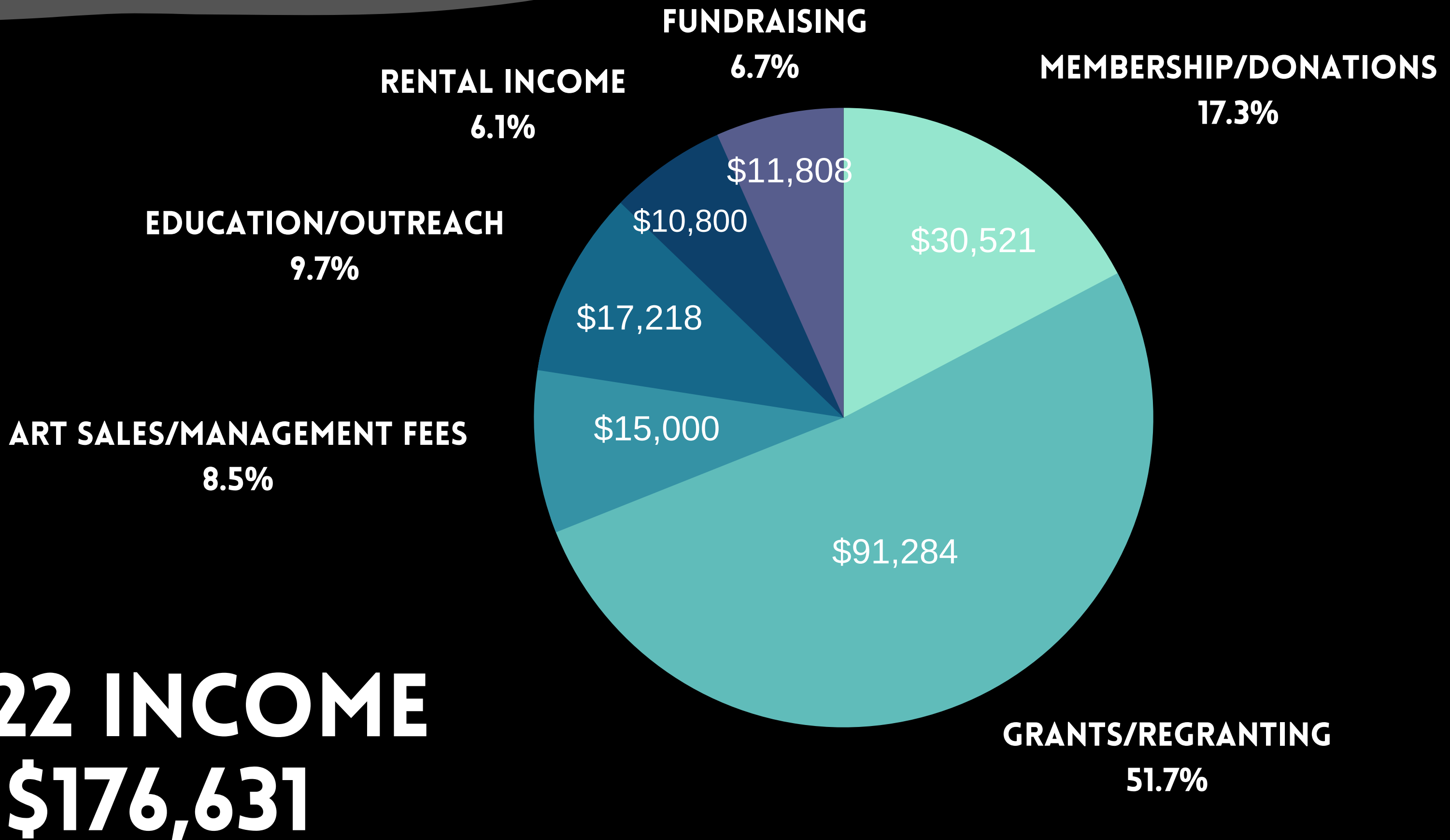

GRANT FUNDS AWARDED TO LOCAL ARTS PROJECTS

The CCCAC is the Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs Regional Regranting coordinator for the six western counties in the UP. This program supports the arts in our region through mini grants for arts projects and professional development opportunities for artists and arts administrators. Minigrants are also available for art supplies and equipment and art field trips for schools. The Regional Regranting program ensures that public funding for the arts reaches every part of the state. Last year we awarded a total of \$34,475 from the MCACA and were able to grant funds to eight organizations and one individual located in four of the six counties we serve.
