Kerredge Gallery Exhibition: Settling Down

Acrylic paintings and gelatin prints by Wisconsin artist Laura Maze
September 2-30, 2020

Laura earned her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Northern Michigan University. Though she majored in printmaking she explored various other two dimensional mediums including drawing and painting. After university she traveled and lived in other parts of the country. During this time she focused on painting. Not having access to a printmaking studio inspired her to start working with readily available materials such as gelatin plates and water based inks. Gelatin plates allow for layering color and drawing into the ink before it is transferred onto paper.

Her paintings and prints are about color and expression; some are straight forward representations, a sway of palm trees, a sailboat on the water in moonlight. Some are more stylized with brush strokes making layered patches of color and playful tree shapes suggesting landscape. Laura says, "My artwork has been a balance between printing and painting, and working with both has given me the opportunity to experiment with medium and process."
