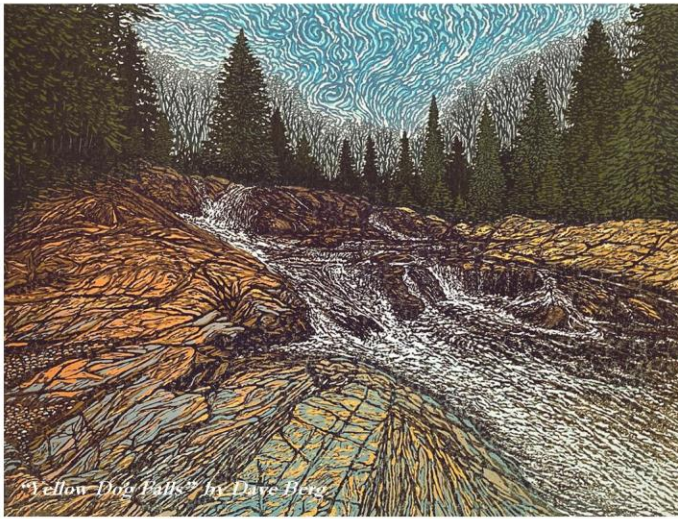

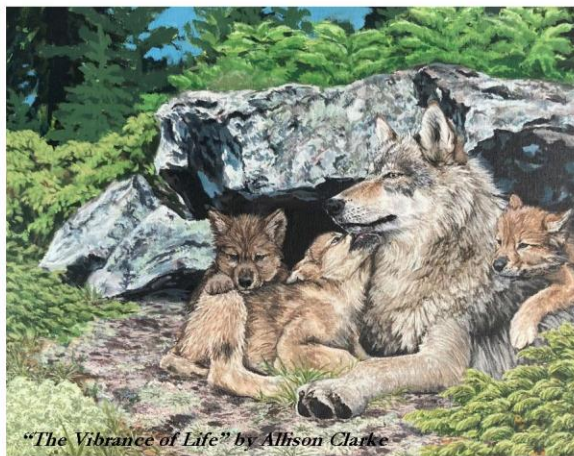

Dave Berg is a native of Michigan's Upper Peninsula. He chose reduction block printing to reflect his love for the UP wilderness. He was attracted to the process and all that it entailed, from hand carving the blocks to inking multiple layers of texture and color to capture the beauty

for portraiture and realism. She is a graduate of Edgewood College in Madison, Wisconsin with a bachelor's degree in Art Therapy and a minor in Psychology. Her main mediums are water soluble oil paint and watercolors. She is versed in a variety of media including photography, pottery, papermaking, drawing and colored pencil work. In addition to free art programs, Allison will give a talk and speak about her experiences as a teen artist in residence and recent returning artist in residence. She will share photos of Isle Royale and of her own artwork.

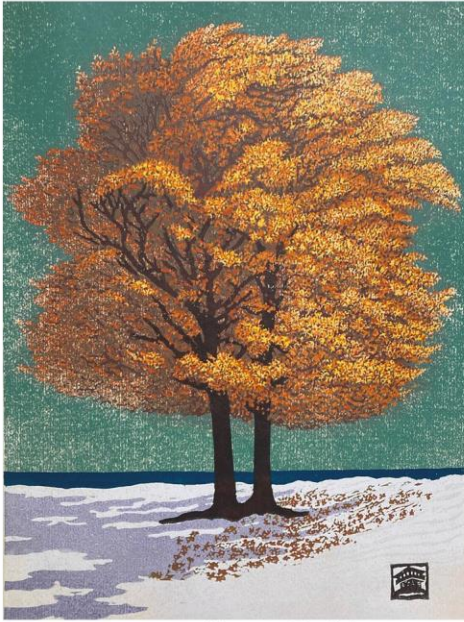
